EMERGENCY PROCEDURES **24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 944 955**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.
Spill or leak	Wear overalls, gloves, footwear, facemask or goggles. Prevent further spillage and product from entering waterways. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Absorb spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water and detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with dry powder or foam. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in Eyes:	Hold eyelids open and rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical advice/attention.
If on Skin:	Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin thoroughly with soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin. Wash clothing before reuse. If irritation persists get medical attention.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical attention.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store in a locked area. Store in original container, tightly closed, in a well ventilated area, as cool as possible, out of direct sunlight. Protect from temperatures above 40 °C. Do NOT store near food, feedstuffs, animals, or fertilisers. Keep away from sources of ignition such as heat/sparks/open flame/hot surfaces.

AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current standard NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals or the HSNO Regulations.

DO NOT STORE OR LOAD WITH: Class 1, 2.1, 2.3, 7.	SEGREGATE FROM: Class 4.2, 4.3, 5.1, 5.2 Foodstuffs or Food Containers
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Segregation: In store separate by at least 5 metres, on transport separate by at least 3 metres, in both cases horizontally. On vehicles an approved segregation device may be used: Check the Land Transport Rule Dangerous Goods, Rule 45001 for additional information. Sea transport may require additional segregation. Refer to NZS5433 Sea Segregation for details.
