IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills. Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.
Spill or leak	Do not breathe vapour/spray. Wear personal protective clothing. Prevent further spillage. Dike spillage. Pump off product. Dispose of absorbed material in accordance with regulations. Collect waste in suitable containers, which can be labeled and sealed. Clean contaminated floors and objects thoroughly with water and detergents, observing environmental regulations. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and breathing apparatus. During a fire, toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish warehouse fires with water spray, dry powder, CO ₂ or foam. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
If on Skin:	Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Do NOT scrub the skin. Wash clothing before reuse.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell.
